### DATA SNAPSHOT

#### 2022 NAPLAN Writing Results

- **Year 3** - Decrease in the percentage of students in the Upper 2 Bands.
- **Year 5** - increase in the percentage of students in the Upper 2 Bands.

#### 2022 SRS English Results

- The percentage of students receiving a 'Well Above' or 'Above' in English is below the average of BCE Schools.

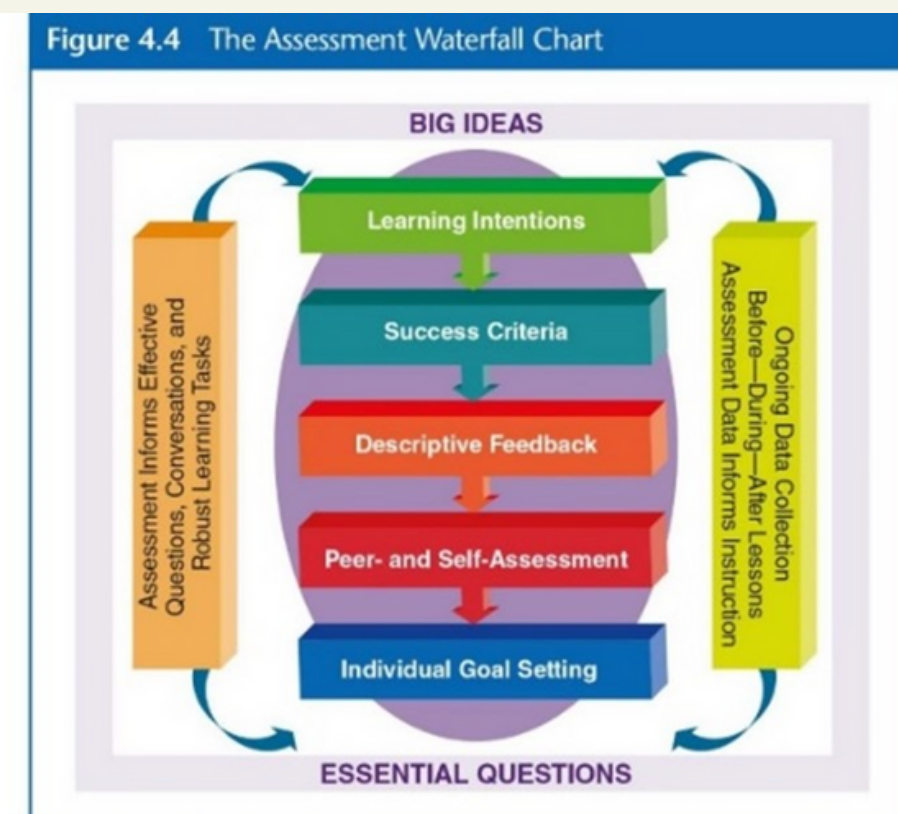


### PEDAGOGY

Establish a consistent whole school approach to assessment and feedback using the **"Assessment Waterfall Chart."**



## WHAT?



### KEY ACTIONS

*We will:*

- Strengthen our current curriculum planning processes and documentation.
- Design open-ended assessment tasks so that all students have an opportunity to demonstrate their learning.
- Teachers provide specific, timely and meaningful feedback to students.
- Introduce a 'Writer's Notebook' for each student.
- Implement a Writing DATA Wall A-E and monitor progress closely.
- Implement regular Learning Walks and Talks to guide the professional learning provided to teachers.

## MEASURES?



### KEY INDICATORS

#### PEDAGOGICAL CONSISTENCY ACROSS THE SCHOOL

- Expected Practices in Writing (and Reading) are known and evidenced in every classroom.
- Students can answer the five learning questions.

#### SRS DATA

- 32% of students are achieving 'Above' or 'Well Above' in English
- No regression!

#### NAPLAN

- Grow the GREEN in NAPLAN by 10%

#### BCE LITERACY MONITORING TOOLS

- No regression!
